

Central Valley High School's Title VI Nondiscrimination Policy Statement

It is the policy of Central Valley High School's Clubs and Organizations to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, The Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1973, the Age Discrimination Acts of 1975, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, Executive Order 12898 (Environmental Justice in minority and low income populations), and Executive Order 13166 (Limited English Proficiency).

To this end, Central Valley High School Clubs and Organizations assure that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, and disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any club or organization at Central Valley High School regardless of whether those programs and activities are federally funded or not.

Central Valley High School also assures that every effort will be made to prevent discrimination through the impacts of its programs, policies, and activities on minority and low income populations. In addition, Central Valley High School will take reasonable steps to provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English Proficiency.
